Headquartered in Nairobi, Kenya, Amref Health Africa has offices in ten countries in Africa – Burkina Faso, Ethiopia, Guinea (Conakry), Kenya, Malawi, Senegal, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda and Zambia. An additional eleven advocacy and fundraising offices are located in Europe and North America.

Amref Health Africa is driven by its vision of 'Lasting health change in Africa' and its mission 'To catalyze and drive community-led and people-centred health systems while addressing social determinants of health'. GAVI CSO HOSTING ARRANGEMENT

Amref Health Africa was named host of the Gavi Civil Society Organization (CSO) Steering Committee (SC) in 2022. In this hosted partnership, Amref Health Africa will work with a wide array of civil society organizations to support Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance's goals to achieve the global Immunization Agenda 2030 and Gavi's Strategy for 2021-2025 including integration of COVID -19 vaccines into Gavi's core programmes. Amref, as the host, will provide coordination, strategic advisory services, constituency governance systems and process management, communications and administrative services, including advocacy, networking and knowledge management.

JOB PURPOSE

The CSO Regional Lead will oversee the CSO SC activities and coordination in the Asia region. S/he will report directly to the Programme Manager. In this role, it is expected that s/he will work in collaboration with the Advocacy Manager, Communications and Liaison Officer and Gavi CSO Steering Committee to deepen the engagement of Gavi CSO partners in immunisation activities in this region.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Regional Lead

- Work with the Programme Manager and the Gavi CSO SC programme implementation in the Asia region
- Develop and manage a knowledge management (KM) strategy
- Work closely with the Advocacy Manager, Communication and Liaison Officer in enhancing Gavi CSO's agenda in the region
- Manage a CSO Constituency membership database to ensure up to date member details and increase membership transparency and visibility through real time analytics on geographic location, technical expertise, and other organisational characteristics across Constituency members
- Support CSO mapping efforts, in close coordination with the Gavi Secretariat and other aligned donors and partners

- Provide timely information on Gavi Full Portfolio Planning (FPP) and national processes to Constituency Members
- Propose and promote creative solutions for knowledge management that support the CSO hosting arrangement's objectives
- Support the establishment and facilitation of a community of practice (CoP) for CSOs, and foster systematic learning across the Gavi Alliance, Gavi CSO Constituency and broader CSO and health space

Knowledge Management

- Actively liaise with Gavi CSO partners in Asia
- Prepare KM and management analytical reports
- Support the establishment of and management of the operation of KM online tools and monitoring the same
- Organize and implement trainings for the core team on KM
- Work with the Programme Manager, Advocacy Manager and SC representative to convene monthly coordinating calls with the Constituency in order to strengthen linkage
- Support the development and dissemination of knowledge and experience through enhanced communication, strengthened knowledge products and publications
